

Satellite Family Fees

Satellite is a non-profit organization, which maintains a network of Madison Accredited family child care homes.

The primary funding source of Satellite and Madison Accreditation is the City of Madison, with the remaining amount of funding coming from parent and provider fees, United Way and various fundraising efforts.

Enrollment Fee: There is a one time \$20 enrollment fee which is due at the time of enrollment. This is a per family fee. Families will not be charged another enrollment fee when enrolling additional children, enrolling with a different Satellite provider, or re-enrolling a child with a Satellite provider at a later date.

Quarterly Fees: Parents are charged a quarterly parent membership fee based on the number of hours a child is in care. Fees for one child in care are:

Hours Per Week	Amount of Parent Fees	
	Weekly	Quarterly
10 or less per week	\$1.15	\$15.00
11-34 per week	\$1.70	\$22.00
35 or more per week	\$2.70	\$35.00

Note: Quarters are 13 weeks each

- Quarterly fees for more than one child in care are charged at 50% of the rate for the first child.
- If a child is absent from care for one quarter (13 weeks) the parents will not be charged parent fees for the quarter.
- If a provider closes her child care for a period of six consecutive weeks or more, the parents will not be charged parent fees for the time the child care program is closed.
- Parents are billed at the end of each quarter.
- **All fees** are waived for income-eligible families.
- There are no parent fees at the Affiliate provider level.
